

MESSAGING GUIDANCE FOR AFFILIATES ON MILITARIZATION & IMMIGRATION ENFORCEMENT

Purpose: This resource equips Affiliates with clear messaging to engage communities, media, and policymakers around recent federal immigration enforcement actions and militarization. UnidosUS advocates for an immigration strategy that is **firm** in enforcing clear rules at the border, **fair** in ensuring access to protection and due process, and **free of cruelty** by ending dehumanizing treatment and vigilante enforcement.

Key Messaging Buckets

- **Impact on Children**: 6 million U.S. citizen children live in mixed-status families. Deportations tear apart families and futures.
- **Economic Fallout**: Removing 8 million undocumented workers disrupts agriculture, construction, caregiving, and small businesses.
- **Abuse of Power**: Bypassing court orders and empowering vigilantes erodes trust in government and harms all Americans.

Talking Points on Militarization

- The military's role is to defend our nation—not patrol neighborhoods. Deploying troops in cities undermines constitutional safeguards and weakens democracy.
- Families are being torn apart. Law-abiding individuals—workers, parents, and community members—are being swept into deportation.
- Civil rights violations against one community threaten the dignity and security of all Americans.

Affiliate Actions & Advocacy

- **Support Congressional Action**: Advocate for prohibiting federal funds for military/National Guard deployments in cities via the Continuing Resolution, appropriations, and NDAA.
- **Push for Oversight**: Call for hearings on racial profiling, wrongful detentions, and misuse of military forces.
- **Demand Transparency**: Urge DHS and ICE to report enforcement actions that respect privacy, due process, and constitutional rights.
- **Restore Protections**: Reinstate funding and legal counsel for detained individuals, especially children and separated families.
